



Caution: Clostebol

In recent months, positive findings for the prohibited substance clostebol have become increasingly common.

The substance can be easily transmitted through skin-to-skin or contact with the environment.



What is clostebol?

In some regions, including Italy and parts of South America, clostebol is an ingredient in creams and sprays used to treat skin conditions.

In many cases, these products are available without prescription.

Protect yourself

- 1** Check ingredients before using any over-the-counter products
- 2** If you require prescriptions, tell your doctor you are subject to anti-doping testing, and verify that medications are safe to take
- 3** Retain receipts and keep records of your products
- 4** Wash your hands often in communal areas, avoid sharing towels and hygiene items
- 5** Educate your team members and instruct them not to use clostebol before or during physical contact
